

<b>Name of Tool:</b>	Adolescent Chemical Dependency Inventory-Corrections Version II (ACDI-Corrections Version II)

<b>Description:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The ACDI-Corrections Version II is a 140-item, self report actuarial assessment intended for use with juveniles who have had contact with juvenile court or juvenile probation authorities to identify risk and subsequent supervision levels.</li> <li>• The items comprise seven scales: (1) Truthfulness, (2) Violence (3) Adjustment (4) Distress, (4) Alcohol, (5) Drug, and (6) Stress Coping Abilities</li> <li>• Percentile scores are used for risk classification “Low Risk,” “Medium Risk,” “Problem Risk”, and “Severe Problem.”</li> <li>• Risk classifications, along with clinical judgment, are used to inform treatment recommendations.</li> <li>• Truthfulness Scale detects probationer denial, problem minimization, and response bias.</li> <li>• Test administration requires 25-30 minutes and can be completed using traditional paper/pencil methods or using a computer.</li> <li>• Demonstrated reliability and validity.</li> </ul>
<b>Tool Development</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Internal (unpublished) studies provide evidence of validity, reliability and accuracy.
