The ACDI contains 105 items that comprise 6 scales: Truthfulness Scale Alcohol Scale Drug Scale Distress Scale Adjustment Scale Adjustment Scale Scores are used to classify risk into four categories: Low Risk Medium Risk Problem Risk and Severe Problem These classifications, along with clinical judgment, are used to inform treatment recommendations. Truthfulness Scale detects offender denial, problem minimization, and response bias.

	The ACDI is a computerized assessment that provides clinicians with a printed report that includes percentile scores, risk classification, and item responses. The ACDI takes 15-20 minutes to complete. Tests can be administered individually or in group settings.
