	This assessment is an adult court test that is appropriate for evaluating misdemeanor and felony defendants, both male and female. The OAI has 158 items that comprise seven scales (measures): Truthfulness Scale Alcohol Scale Drug Scale Resistance Scale Violence Scale Stress Management Scale Substance Use Disorder classification The OAI measures important offender attitudes, problems with alcohol and drugs, and behavioral (violence) areas of inquiry. The OAI classifies substance abuse with DSM-5 criteria, while concurrently measuring alcohol and drug abuse severity. Scores are used to classify risk into four categories: Low Risk Medium Risk Problem Risk and Severe Problem These classifications, along with clinical judgment, are used to inform treatment recommendations. Truthfulness Scale detects offender denial, problem minimization, and response bias.

	OAI is a computerized assessment that provides clinicians with a printed report that includes percentile scores, risk classification, and item responses. Tests can be administered individually or in group settings. The OAI takes about 30 minutes to complete.
