Description:	<p>Designed for evaluating juveniles (12 to 18 years) accused or convicted of sexual offenses. The SAI-Juvenile has 230 items and takes an hour to complete. It has 13 scales, which include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sex Item Truthfulness Scale • Test Item Truthfulness Scale • Sexual Adjustment Scale • Exhibitionism Scale • Molestation Scale • Sexual Assault Scale • Incest Classification • Violence Scale • Alcohol Scale • Drug Scale • Impulsiveness Scale • Distress Scale • Antisocial Scale <p>Scores are used to classify risk into four categories:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Low Risk • Medium Risk • Problem Risk and • Severe Problem <p>These classifications, along with clinical judgment, are used to inform treatment recommendations.</p> <p>Truthfulness Scale detects offender denial, problem minimization, and response bias.</p> <p>Demonstrated reliability and validity.</p>
