Description:	<p>This is a unique shoplifter test that simultaneously evaluates motivation, attitude and need. The seven Shoplifting Inventory scales explore areas of inquiry considered necessary for adequately understanding shoplifters. Appropriate for males and females ages 13 and up. The seven Shoplifting Inventory scales (measures) include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Truthfulness Scale • Shoplifting Scale • Peer Pressure Scale • Impulsiveness Scale • Self-Esteem Scale • Alcohol Scale • Drug Scale <p>Scores are used to classify risk into four categories:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Low Risk • Medium Risk • Problem Risk and • Severe Problem <p>These classifications, along with clinical judgment, are used to inform treatment recommendations.</p> <p>Truthfulness Scale detects offender denial, problem minimization, and response bias.</p> <p>Demonstrated reliability and validity.</p>
