The Veteran Information Profile, or VIP, uses 163-items to assess eight veteran post-deployment scales (areas of inquiry): Truthfulness Scale Civilian Reintegration Scale Self-Esteem Scale Depression Scale PTSD Scale Suicide Scale Alcohol Scale Drug Scale Low Risk Medium Risk Problem Risk and Severe Problem These classifications, along with clinical judgment, are used to inform treatment recommendations. Truthfulness Scale detects offender denial, problem minimization, and response bias.
