Description:	<p>The Parolee Inventory (PI) is an objective, comprehensive and standardized screening instrument that examines important attitudes and behaviors. Very few assessment instruments or tests are designed specifically for parolee evaluation.</p> <p>The PI contains 135 items that comprise 8 scales:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Truthfulness Scale • Distress Scale • Antisocial Scale • Violence Scale • Stress Management • Self-Esteem Scale • Alcohol Scale • Drug Scale <p>Scores are used to classify risk into four categories:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Low Risk • Medium Risk • Problem Risk and • Severe Problem <p>These classifications, along with clinical judgment, are used to inform treatment recommendations.</p> <p>Truthfulness Scale detects offender denial, problem minimization, and response bias.</p> <p>Demonstrated reliability and validity.</p>
Tool Development	<p>A summary of scientific findings is available for download.</p>
General Notes:	<p>The PI is a computerized assessment that provides clinicians with a printed report that includes percentile scores, risk classification, and item responses.</p> <p>The PI takes 25-30 minutes to complete.</p> <p>Tests can be administered individually or in group settings.</p>
